- **Maximum of 10 players per team**
- (2) 13 minute periods with a short warm up before the game.
Players are strongly advised to stretch before games.

Tournament Details

- All players must bring proper running shoes, gloves and stick and **HELMET & MASK**. It is up to the parent to decide what additional protective gear is worn. For example: jock, shin guards.
